Note: A grade of C- or better must be earned in order for a class to transfer. Maximum credits that can be transferred to PNCA is 72 credits. Transfer students must complete at least 48 credits at PNCA. Most studio courses taken at Community Colleges that do not meet the PNCA Foundation Studio courses will transfer in as Studio Electives. Design, Illustration, Animation, and Video/Sound majors may have additional 2nd year requirements. It is recommended that all students take courses related to expected major interest, and that Graphic Design majors also take History of Graphic Design. Requirements can be waived by strength of portfolio upon review by Chair of department, though credits must still be earned.
