Note: A grade of C- or better must be earned in order for a class to transfer. Maximum credits that can be transferred to PNCA is 73 credits. Transfer students must complete at least 48 credits at PNCA. Most studio courses taken at Community Colleges that do not meet the PNCA Foundation Studio courses will transfer in as Studio Electives. Design, Illustration, Animation, and Video/Sound majors may have additional 2nd year requirements. It is recommended that all students take courses related to expected major interest. Requirements can be waived by strength of portfolio upon review by Chair of department, though credits must still be earned. If a student at EC gets the proper advising, especially in the aspect of the "Major Requirement" then they may indeed transfer in at the junior level at PNCA with 60 semester credits.
